



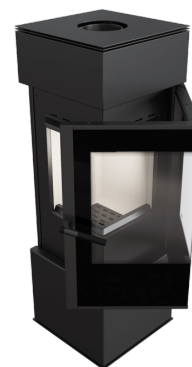
KRATKI THOR 8
